REGIONAL ECONOMIC AND RECOVERY PARTNERSHIP GRANT – LOS ANGELES COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT AND YOUTHSOURCE SYSTEM PARTNERSHIP TO CO-LOCATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE MENTORS AT YOUTHSOURCE CENTERS

#### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

This directive is effective upon the date of issue.

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this directive is to officially launch and outline expectations for the Regional Economic and Recovery Partnership (RERP) Grant and a new partnership to co-locate Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) Mentors throughout the City of Los Angeles (City) fourteen (14) YouthSource Centers (YSC).

#### **BACKGROUND**

The RERP Grant represents acceleration of Regional Plan Implementation efforts and seeks to support its sector strategies and career pathways programs that will achieve economic growth, economic equity, job quality, and job access by funding partnerships between Local Workforce Development Board and Community College Regional Consortia.

Aligned with the YSC System redesign, the RERP project will aid the efforts to increase access to career pathways in high-wage occupations for YSC participants through the strategic collaboration between the YSCs and nine Community Colleges within LACCD. The partnership will support the YSCs in achieving their goal of co-enrolling 70 percent of YSC participants into Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs. The Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD) and the LACCD will co-locate LACCD Mentors throughout the 14 YSCs to assist YSC participants better navigate the LACCD programs and resources and strengthen the co-enrollment strategy between the nine Community Colleges and the YSC system. Through this partnership, participants will have increased access to post-secondary education and Career and Technical Education programs offered through LACCD.

#### **REQUIRED ACTION**

- YSCs shall work collaboratively with Community College Mentors (Mentors) to connect its participants to one of the nine LACCD colleges for advisement, enrollment, financial aid, and other services critical for success.
- YSCs are expected to follow best practices with respect to co-location of Mentors associated with colleges identified in Table 1 below. The assigned Mentors will serve as the point of contact and resolve any issues that may arise.
  - Mentors will staff each of the 14 YSC for approximately 10 hours per week.
- YSCs shall designate a staff to work alongside the LACCD Program Director to coordinate its efforts to connect YSC participants to programs and resources offered by LACCD colleges and other community-based organizations.
- The YSCs shall work with the assigned Mentor who will assist in conducting orientations, college and career exploration, and enrollment of participants in any of the LACCD's nine community colleges.
- YSCs shall participate in monthly and semi-annual meetings with Mentors led by the LACCD Program Director hosted at Los Angeles Harbor College or via Zoom to plan, assess, and redirect the program activities as needed.
  - Mentors and program staff will participate in monthly meetings led by LACCD program director/coordinator;
  - LACCD will convene two annual meetings with YSC and EWDD leadership to ensure the program meets goals and objectives; and
  - LACCD program director/coordinator will coordinate and provide necessary training to the Mentors, other LACCD staff, and YSC staff as needed to assist YSC participants with enrolling in LACCD colleges.
